**ORDER GRANTING RECEIVER'S UNOPPOSED
MOTION FOR AUTHORITY TO UNFREEZE AND TRANSFER
FUNDS PREVIOUSLY FROZEN BY RELIANT ACCOUNT MANAGEMENT**

THIS CAUSE came before the Court upon the Receiver's Unopposed Motion for Authority to Unfreeze and Transfer Funds Previously Frozen by Reliant Account Management [DE 74] (the "Motion"), filed herein on May 30, 2018. The Court has carefully considered the Motion and is otherwise fully advised in the premises.

Accordingly, it is hereby **ORDERED and ADJUDGED** that the Motion [DE 74] is **GRANTED**. The previously frozen amount of \$156,330.92, as set forth in the Motion, shall be unfrozen by RAM and promptly transferred by RAM to its customers in the specific amount owed to each customer. As further described in the Motion, the \$2,465.80 previously frozen and payable to Fidelity Debt Reserve LLC shall be unfrozen by RAM and promptly transferred by RAM to the Receiver (on behalf of Receivership Entity Fidelity Debt Reserve LLC); the \$63.75

previously frozen and payable to RAM shall be unfrozen by RAM and promptly transferred by RAM to itself; and the \$115.00 previously frozen and payable to third-party vendor Veritas Legal shall be unfrozen by RAM and promptly transferred by RAM to Veritas Legal.
